Cosmetics-GMP ISO 22716 – How resilient and future-proof is the current standard?

Specialist Lecture

Nationally and Internationally, the implementation of norm ISO 22716 plays an important role within the field of quality assurance. Since the 1990's the cosmetics GMP rules guarantees consistent high quality and functions as a guideline for the manufacturing of cosmetics. Within the EU the EG cosmetics regulation 1223/2009 demands manufacturing according to the cosmetics GMP and since 2011 the European Commission explicitly refers to this norm, which made it the standard of manufacturing quality.

Michael Pfeiffer, expert in the field of cosmetics quality consultancy, will show you the future demands of quality assurance regarding to the current situation. Are there any changes to be expected? What influence do the different standards out of the EU have? Where will the road take us and what demands do private label and manufacturing companies have to face?
